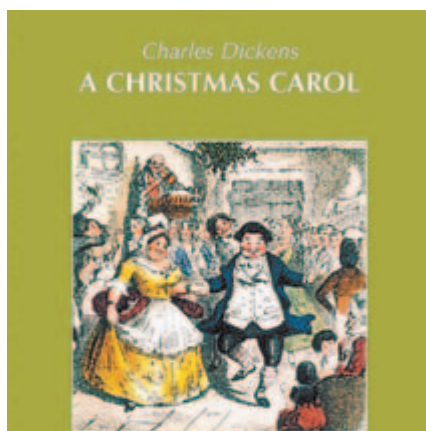

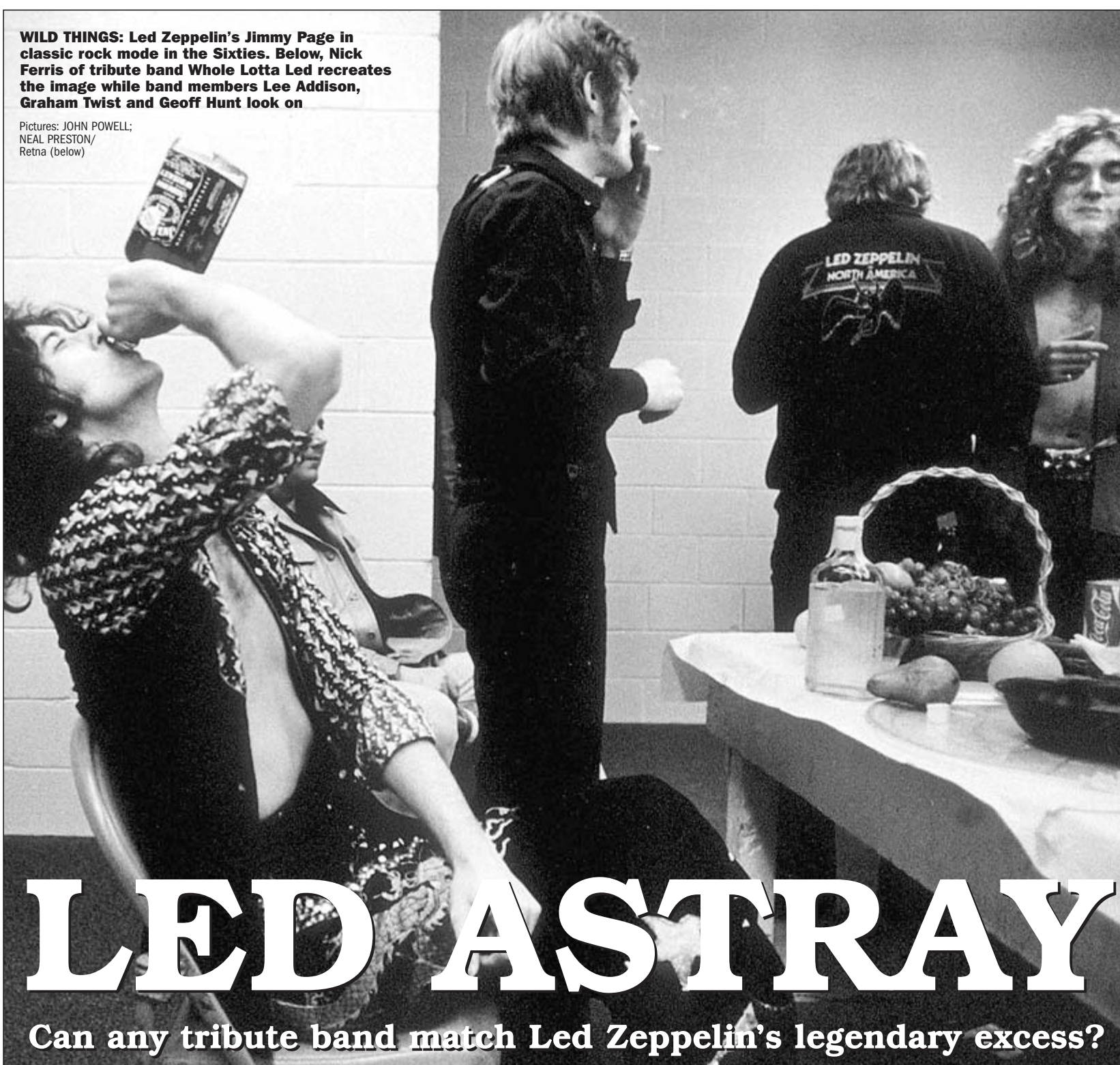
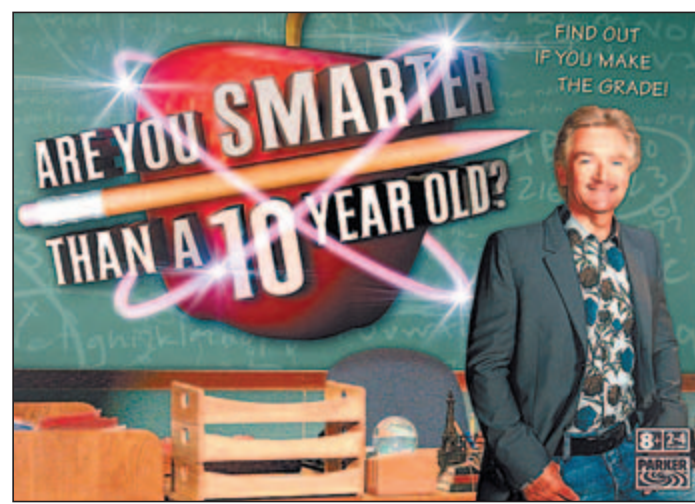

Can any tribute band match Led Zeppelin's legendary excess?

With 100 million desperate fans eager to see Led Zeppelin perform their one-off gig at London's O2 arena in eight days time, **Charlotte Heathcote** joins their alter egos and has a whole lotta fun

AS THE final notes of Led Zeppelin's Whole Lotta Love ring out, the entire audience is on its feet clapping, stamping and screaming for more. The stage is stormed by two awestruck teenage boys. But the sweat-soaked band are all played out after a heady two-hour set and smiling and waving, they disappear offstage. Their dressing room is in stark contrast to the electrifying atmosphere upstairs. It's as brightly lit as an interrogation room, the only sound is the deafening ringing in your ears and, far from buzzing on adrenaline (or an illegal equivalent) the band seem as calm as if they were shopworkers on a tea break. It's a short-lived lull, though. They hardly have time to change out of their sodden clothes before they are

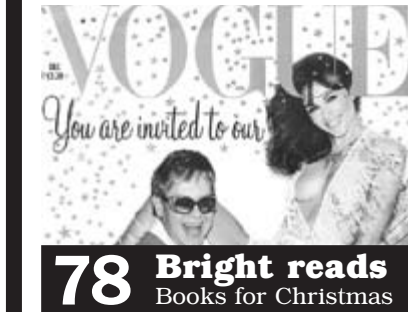
